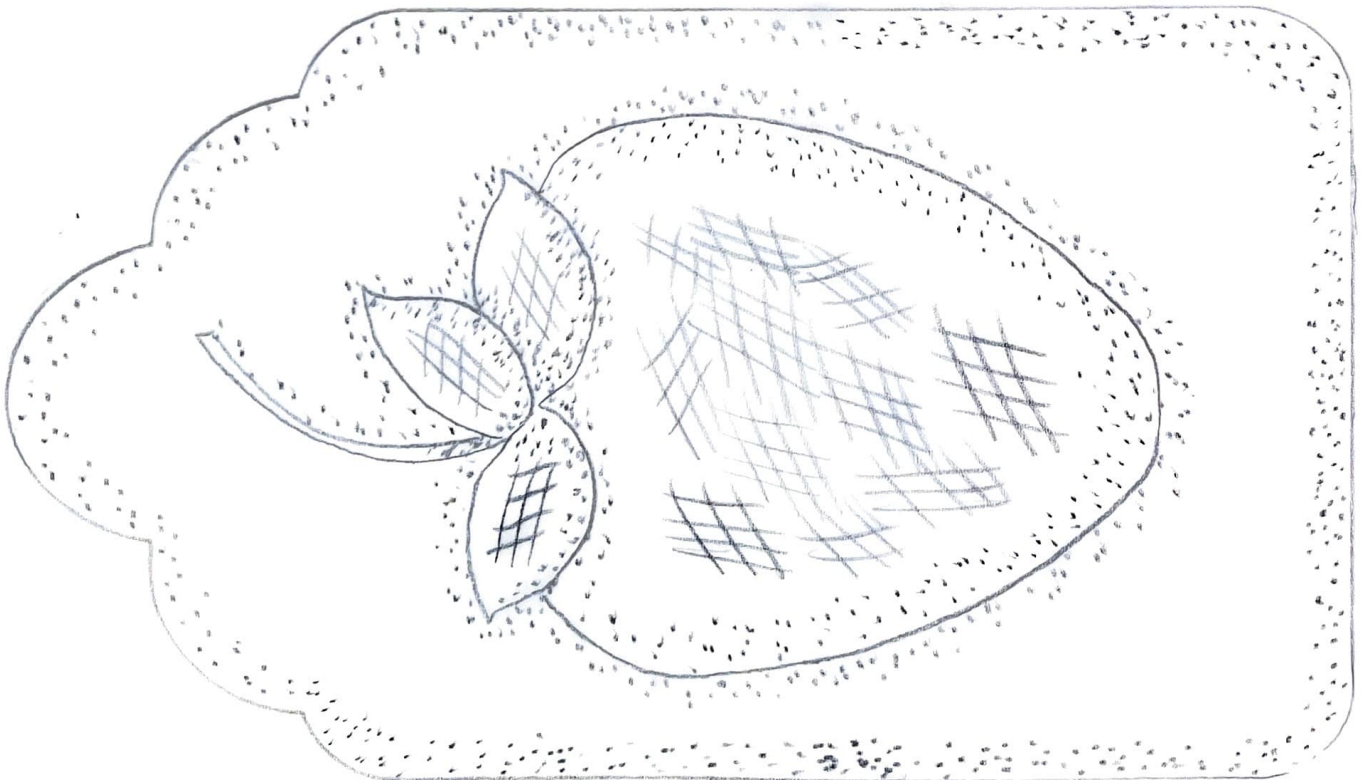
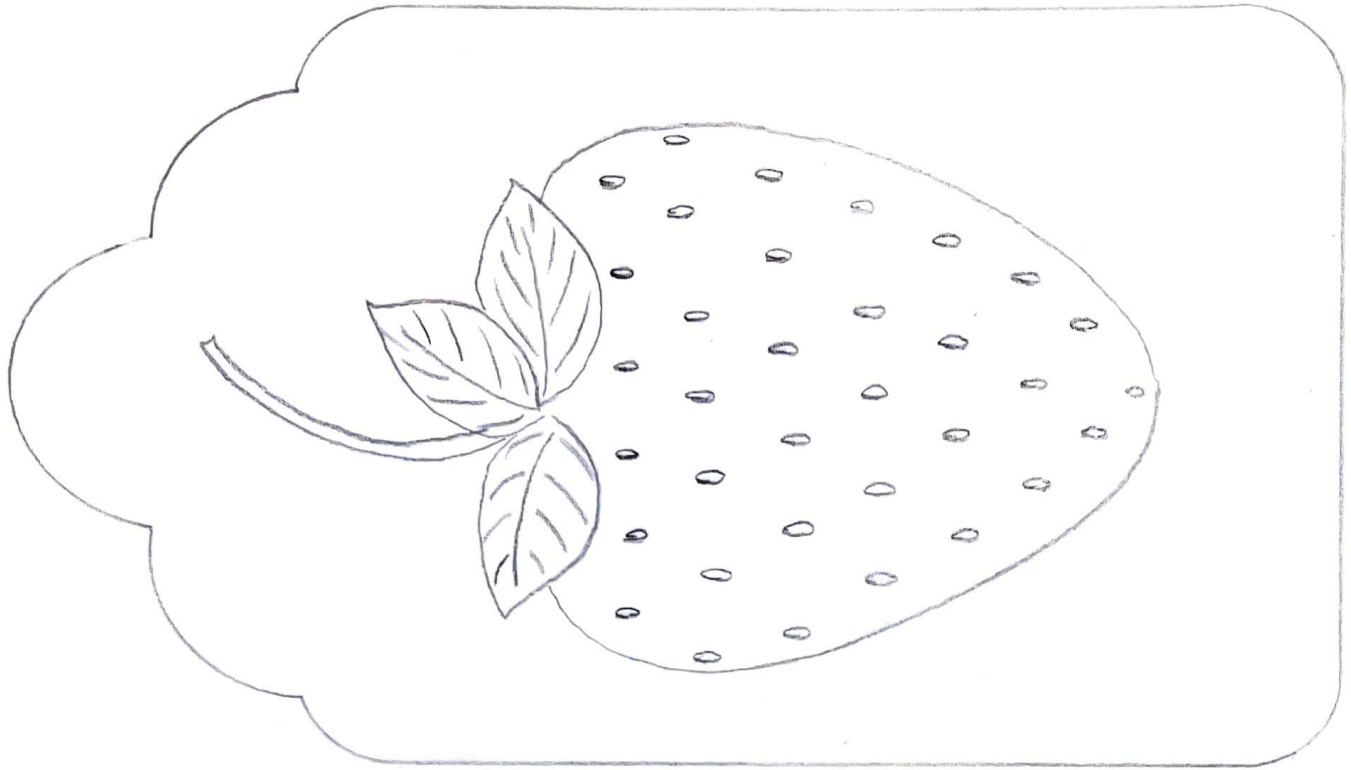

Paint – DecoArt Americana

Asphaltum	Hauser Dark Green
Black Green	Hauser Light Green
Black Plum	Hauser Medium
Bleached Sand	Scarlett Red
Cad Yellow	Snow White

Brushes & Stencil

Flats: 1/2, 1/4

Rounds: #1, #4

Liners: Choice

Mop Bush

Drybrush-med/lg.

Word or any decorative stencil

Prep

Sand the wood and Seal with half multi-purpose sealer and half Bleached Sand. Dry, lightly sand, apply straight Bleached Sand.

Apply the stencil with Black Plum

Apply basic pattern lines for the strawberry, stem, and leaves.

Basecoat the following:

Strawberry: Scarlett Red

Leaf & Stem: Hauser Medium Green

Strawberry:

- Drybrush the center with a brush mix of Cad Yellow and Scarlett Red. Repeat using more Cad Yellow and repeat again using straight Cad Yellow.
- Add Cad Yellow seeds with a liner brush (flatten the brush slightly/press down)
- Float shade around the strawberry and under the leaves with Country Red.
- Repeat lightly with Black Plum
- Float Black Plum under each seed – even the ones that are slightly covered with the float.
- Highlight towards the top of each seed with a tiny dot of Snow White.

Leaves:

- Drybrush leaves with a mix of Hauser Light Green and Cad Yellow
- Float shade at the base & bottom of each leaf & base of stem.
- Repeat with Black Green & add vein lines.
- Float shade around strawberry, leaf, stem and edges with Asphaltum.
- Sides of surface are Asphaltum with Snow White Checks.
