



Winter Pinecone Ornament

Paint Colors

Background is based in Blue Mist; substitution is Laurel..3

Neon Fiery Red

Any Metallic Red

- Seal and sand the wood surface.
- Basecoat the ornament Blue Mist and the cap Country Red.
- Apply basic pattern lines

Pinecone:

- Basecoat Asphaltum
- The scales are a brush mix of Honey Brown and Bleached Sand.
- Paint upside down "C" strokes
- Deepen the base of each scale with Soft Black (float)
- Float highlights across the top with Bleached Sand

Pine Needles:

- Paint the branches with Asphaltum.
- The needles are lined in with Black Green, Hauser Medium, Hauser Light and Snow White.

Boxwood Foliage

- The boxwood stems are lined in with a brush mix of Hauser Dark.
- The leaves are brush mix of Hauser Medium & Hauser Light stroked in with a filbert.
- Float shade the base of each leaf with Hauser Dark and deepen with Black Green.

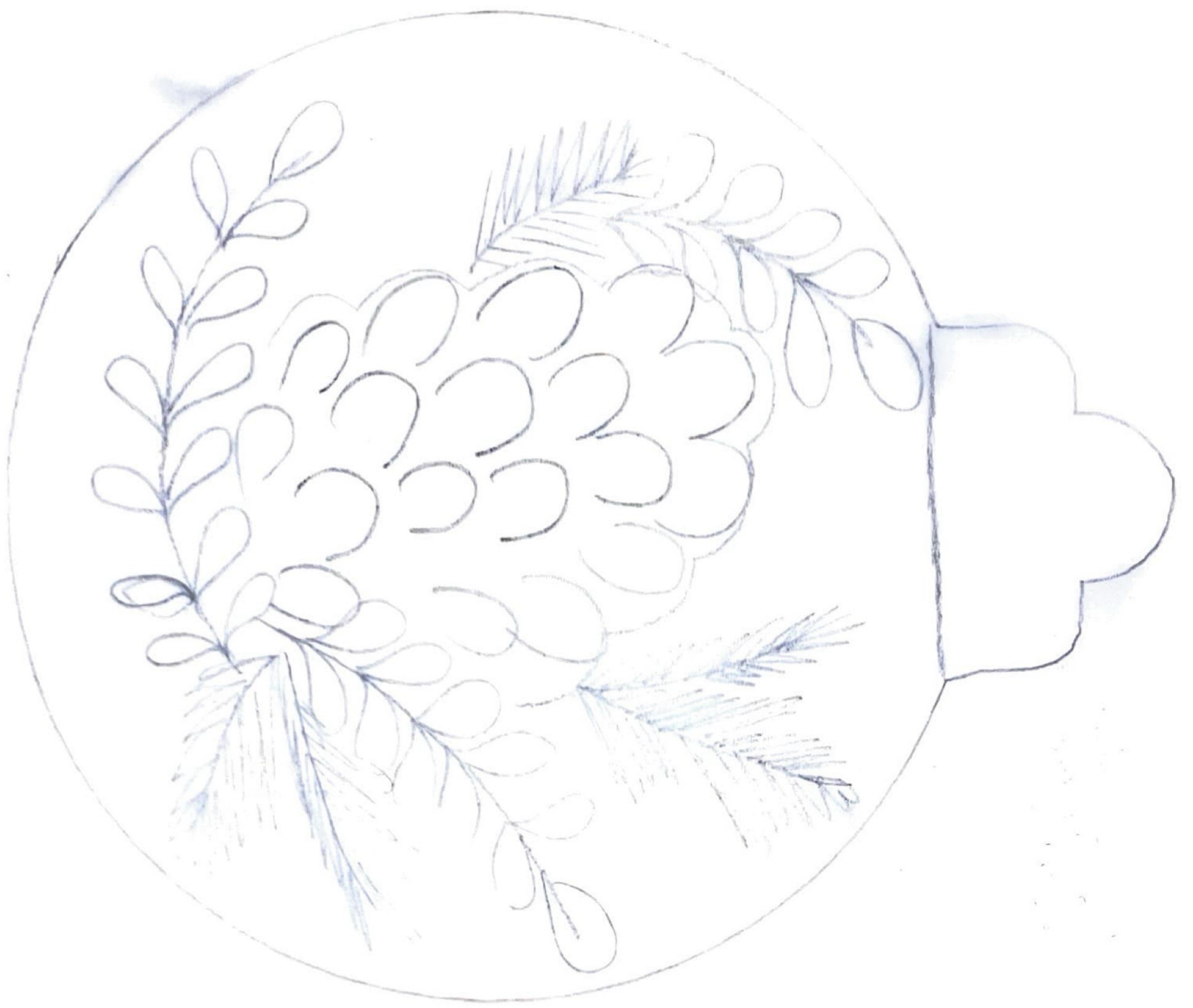
Float highlights on the tips with brush mix of Hauser Light and Snow White.

Berries

- Paint the berries Country Red. Float Black Plum across the bottom and Fiery Red across the tops.
- Using a round brush add mounds of snow on the pinecone, leaves and berries with Snow White.

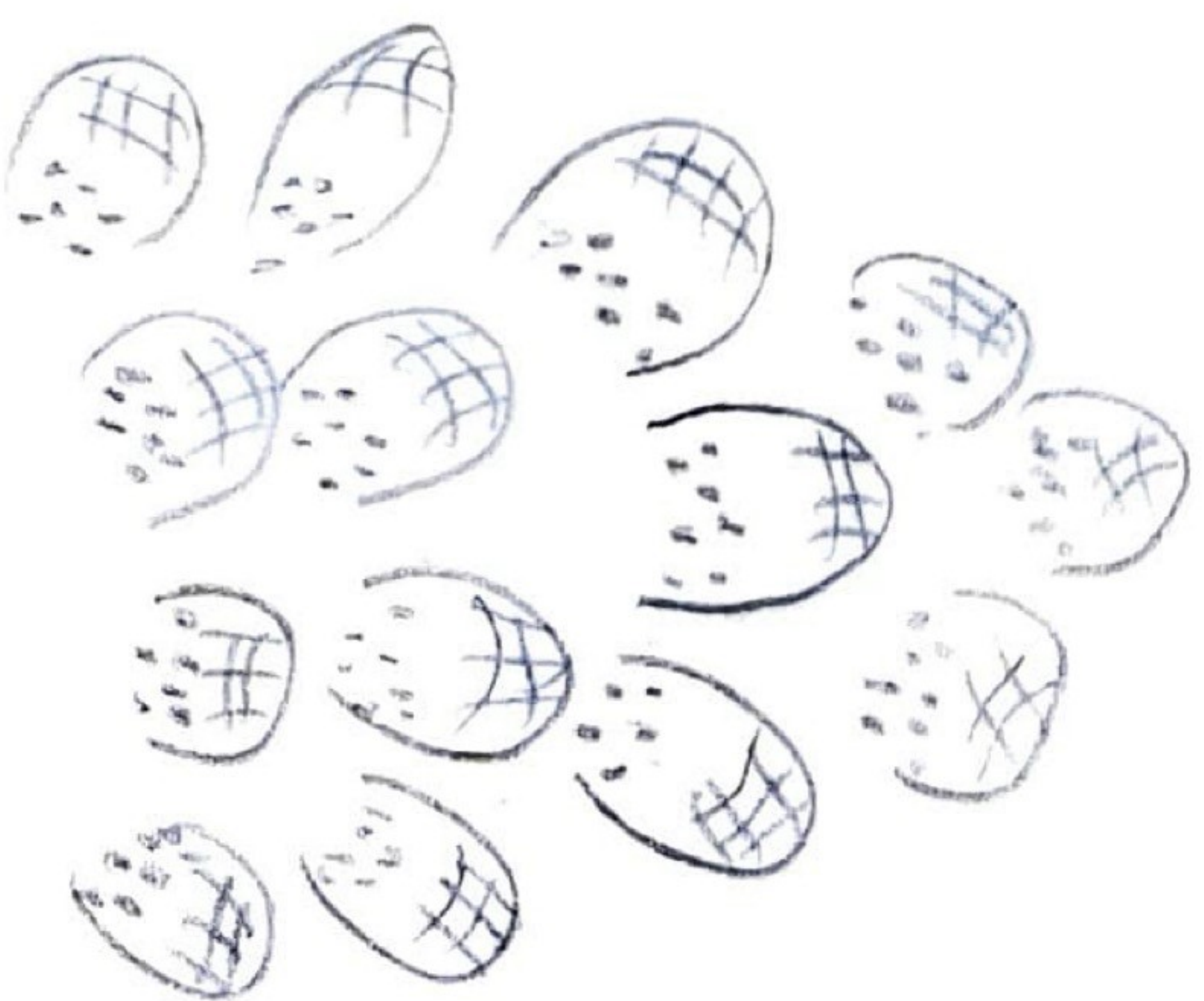
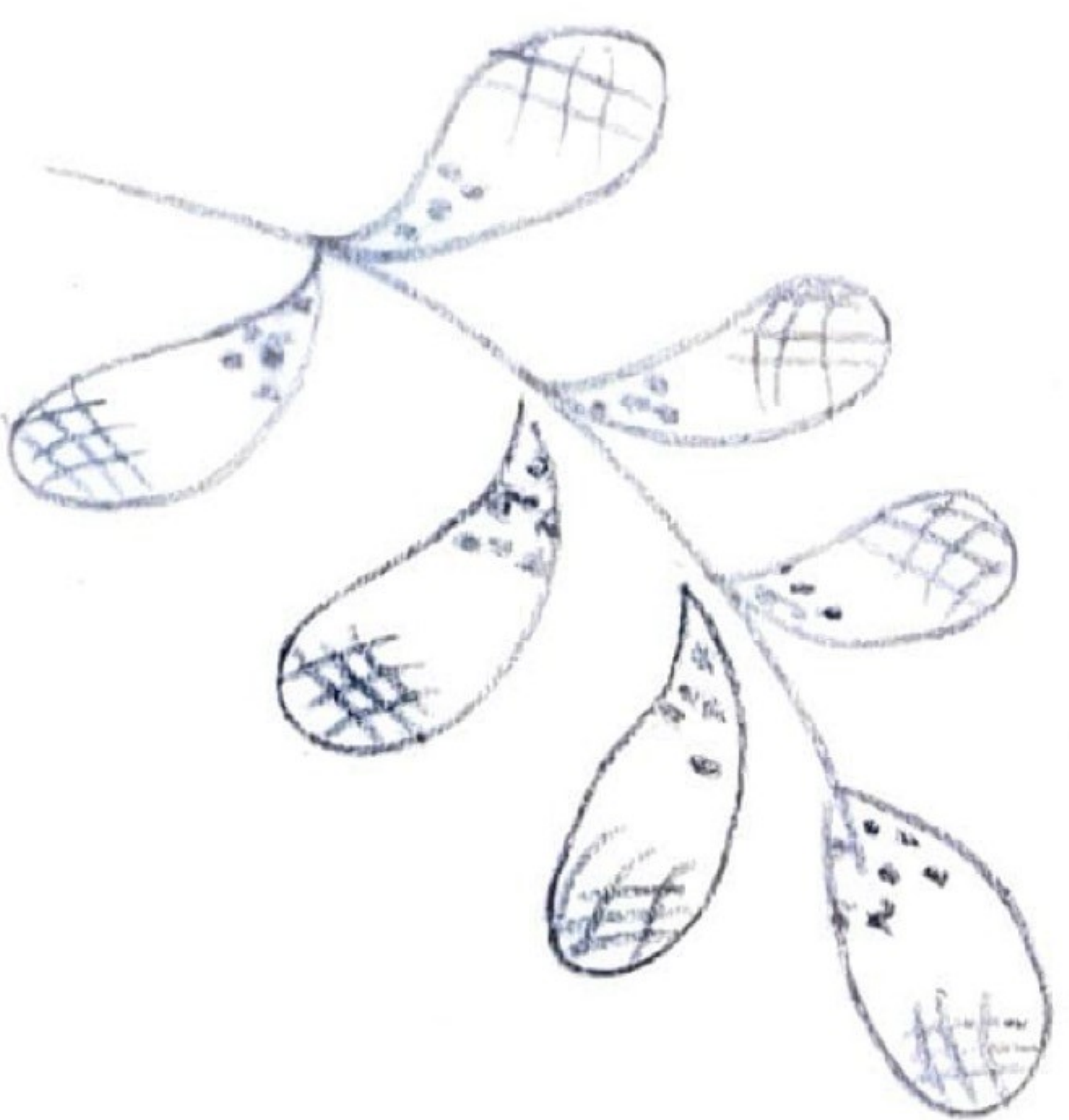
Add speckles of snow and drybrush round snowballs on the background with Snow White.

Float across the bottom of the cap with Black Plum and across the top with Fiery Red.
